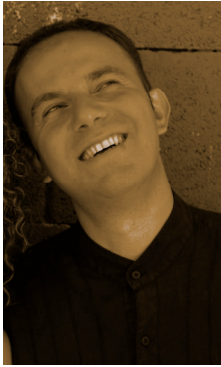

Since the end of his studies in London in 1995 Reinhardt Winkler started an internatinol career and worked with musicians like Wolfgang Puschnig, Paul Urbanek, Andy Manddorf, Rebekka

Bakken, Linda Sharrock, Rick Iannacone, John Sass, Alpine Aspects, Chants, Herbert Joos, Jamaladeen Tacuma, Steve Swallow, Woody Schabata ect.

Together with Karen Astrian´s "Armenian Spirit" he got the World Music Grammy´s Award in Los Angeles in 2007.
